## LJUBLJANA

### City Ljubljana

Ljubljana is considered to be a yet undiscovered gem of Europe. It is often compared with Prague due to its beautiful architectural appearance, which is the result of the legacy of different periods in history and, most notably, the work of the famous 20th century architect Jože Plečnik.

The symbol of Ljubljana is the dragon, which dominates the iconic Dragon Bridge, and the city's most prominent attraction Ljubljana Castle, whose Outlook Tower offers some of the most beautiful views of the city.

The city's largest park, the centrally located Tivoli, is a popular place to relax and spend time or perhaps enjoy one of the interesting exhibitions of

large-format photographs held there on a regular basis.

Metelkova mesto, an alternative culture centre that developed from a squat in a former army barracks and became one of the best known attractions of Ljubljana, brings together a variety of different artistic practices and events. It is home to a large number of clubs hosting a regular programme of concerts, club nights, and one-off club events featuring underground artists and DJs from around the world. The centre also hosts art performances, exhibitions, and an occasional festival. Running a vibrant daily programme of events, it draws together people on any night of the week. The crowd is mixed, including anyone from students and underground music fans to visitors to Ljubljana and professionals enjoying a night out.

### Festival Ljubljana (01 Jul - 01 Sep)





### Open kitchen




## OPEN KITCHEN

#### Park Škocian caves


The Škocjan Caves represent a underground phenomena in both the Karst region and Slovenia. Probably in the Early Pleistocene the ceiling of the cave collapsed some 200 metres from the sinks; as a result, the collapse valleys were created, separated by a natural bridge, a remnant of the original cave ceiling. Above the caves, lies the village of Škocjan.
